4. **Have a good pint.** There's an art to pouring a Guinness, with several steps to it. The Guinness factory in Dublin holds workshops and gives some bars seals of approval. There are good pints to be had at many Irish pubs in NYC include Tracks, on the lower level of Penn Station; Tir Na nOg, at 5 Penn Plaza at Eighth Avenue; Druids Bar and Restaurant, at 736 10th Avenue; Swift Hibernian Lounge, 34 E. 4th St. Can't decide? Go on a pub crawl. You can figure out your own, or join a tour. There are pub crawls in Hoboken and in NYC tomorrow, that include \$2 and 3 beers and \$4 whiskey (prices go up at 9).
